THIS MONTH'S QUESTIONS:

Q: What is national's take on a member living in one city, but when they join they want to join the domain or chapter of another nearby city?
And if they were formed Camarilla members, would that make a difference?

A: If a member lives within the boundaries of a domain or independent chapter, but they want to join another domain or indy chapter instead, this is doable with the same approvals you would need to transfer. Talk to your coordinator chain to see what reasons they think are good reasons, and what reasons they might want to avoid.

Q: When will the 1st Night prestige be released?

A: Soon, I hope. I am now looking into the matter more actively and should at least be able to get an ETA, if not awards, in the next week or two.

V. Projects

MEMBERSHIP HANDBOOK:

Work continues on the new draft of the Membership Handbook. It will not be published until we run out of copies of the existing Handbook, but in order to make sure we have a high quality project, editing work has already begun. If you have comments about policy or content, send them up the coordinator chain or bring up the topic on the coordinators mailing list (or both). Project lead is Wes Contreras, NC.

COMMUNITIES REFORM:

We are compiling a charter for each community with basic information. When complete, these will be posted to the web site and we will then begin a campaign to ensure the membership knows of the communities and can take advantage of what they offer. Project leads are Niki Chase, ANC: Communities and Wes Contreras, NC.

NATIONAL DATABASE DESIGN:

A revised interface for the national database is in beta testing along with several feature enhancements, though some back-end work to tie the Camarilla system to the other White-Wolf systems must be completed before it goes live. Project lead is Brent Cerrato, NTA in cooperation with the White Wolf IT department.

NATIONAL DATABASE MAINTENANCE:

All of the chapters and domains are now created and are assigned to the correct regions. Project lead was Jed Stancato, ANC Chapters.

EDUCATION DEPARTMENT:

The Leadership Handbook is well underway and proceeding rapidly to the first draft stage. Project lead is Jamie Schork-Morency.

UNIFIED EMAIL ADDRESSES:

Due to heavy focus on the national database, this project is on hold indefinitely. Someday it will happen.

OPEN PRESTIGE REVIEWS:

This project is moving along so well that the eligibility date has been moved up to 1999 earlier than anticipated. Project lead is Pearce Dreadin, ANC: Prestige. If you have prestige awards dating to 1999 or earlier that have not already been locked by a national review, you may choose to send up a prestige review through normal channels to have your totals locked by national.

DOMAIN LISTS:

Each domain without a mailing list on the Camarilla server is being contacted to try and set one up. At this time the move is optional. Once we have three months of solid uptime on the Cam server, the move will become mandatory. Project lead is Christy Wellens, ANC: Projects.

DOMAIN / INDY CHAPTER BOUNDARIES:

In cooperation with regional officers, we are checking to ensure that each and every domain and independent chapter has defined geographic boundaries. The GL, EC, NC and SC regions are complete. NE, NW, SW, and SE are incomplete. Project lead is Bill Malvasi, ANC: Admin.

REGIONAL COORDINATOR REPORT TEMPLATE:

A reporting template for the regional coordinators is being reviewed by the RCs, and should be in effect for the next reporting cycle. The project lead for the final stages of this is Wes Contreras, NC.
