THIS MONTH'S QUESTIONS:

Q: Status request for Appeal Issue regarding the removal of DST of AZ-005-D - Tithe of Souls by National.

A: It's being investigated, and it is entirely my fault that it has taken this long, as I forgot to follow up on some emails that were sent. Q: How does the prestige for sending in money for the Katrina Relief work? Is there a specific amount and is it General or National Prestige?

- Names and Cam numbers for everyone who helped, along with what they did
- A scan of your receipt from the American Red Cross (if you cannot scan it, contact me for alternatives)

Prestige will be awarded per the normal prestige chart based on what each person did to contribute to the fundraiser. A portion of this prestige will be national. All of it will be documented in the national prestige database.

Q: Will NEGLECT prestige possibly be released by ICC? It's been 5 months, and some of our members are waiting on that prestige for MC increases.

A: Given that ICC is next week, this seems unlikely. There were some questions about some of the awards and those questions need to be answered before they can be approved - hopefully this will happen soon.
