V. Questions & Answers

NEW QUESTIONS:

Q: If I received early renewal prestige in February of 2003, and I renew again in December, do I get early renewal prestige again? The current guidelines say only one award per calendar year.
A: The new prestige guidelines did not take effect until April 1, 2003, so any early renewal prestige earned prior to that does ***NOT*** count towards

your one per calendar year. Thus, if you received early renewal prestige in February (before April 1, 2003), you may receive the award again in September, October, November, or whenever it is that you did (or will) renew your membership again.

To say it again - yes, you CAN receive early renewal prestige for renewing in December (or in the last few months) even if you already got 50 prestige in February or March.

Q: If I was a DC for the month of November, but my prestige award isn't reported until December 15, what date do I list in my prestige log?

A: Always list prestige awards during the month they were earned, even if that's not the month during which they were reported. For example, if you were DC in November, then the award should be listed in the month of November and will apply towards your Administration category cap for November.

Q: How would I go about recommending someone for Trustee status (MC15)?

A: You would contact a member of the Camarilla Council and make your case to them regarding the recommendation.

Q: If a member was granted MC 4 by a previous CC, and then loses his log, can tracking officially begin at MC 4 minimum or does it start over at 0?

A: If his prestige was reported properly, then the log can be reconstructed based on old chapter reports (and others). First talk to your RC, as they often have archives of old reports. If that doesn't produce results, contact to Chuck Childers, the ANC: Chapters, at chuck.childers@comcast.net for copies of old reports to review. If the log cannot be reconstructed, then use your coordinator chain of command to inquire about alternatives.

Q: Are we still on-target for a November 30th Release of the Membership Handbook in PDF?

A: Due to a family emergency with the final graphical layout person, there has been a delay of a day or two. It should be available on the 1st or 2nd.

Q: Which of the new educational materials will be available after the release of the Handbook? When will members be able to start taking those new tests? What is the estimated turn-around time for correcting those exams?

A: The first ordeal should be released concurrently with the Handbook, with members able to take the exam immediately. Turnaround time is unknown until we have more information on volume and logistics.

Q: There are a considerable number of Problems and Questions from reports that involve Member Services in Part 2 of this report. Most of these appear to be dealing with missing Camarilla numbers or payment issues.

A: This isn't a question. :) The point of contact to resolve these issues is Stephanie Mayes, the National Services Administrator (formerly known as Membership Services until the new constitution came out). She can be reached at memberservices@white-wolf.com. If this does not resolve your issues, use the coordinator chain of command to address the issues - be sure to include specific details.

LAST MONTH'S QUESTIONS:

Q: Why did the domain codes change?

A: Not only does it simply tracking groups that change from chapter to domain status, but the new system allows more units per state. The old system was actually within about a year of running out of numbers in some places, and with the other added benefits, this seemed like a better time to change over than next year.

VI. Projects

(Project status is listed as of the time of this report, not necessarily the first of the month.)

ARBITRATION BOARD:

The Board is now live and accepting cases. To appeal a regional decision, contact Daniel Hahn, the ANC: Arbitration, at daniel.hahn@charter.net.

Project is completed, though maintenance will be ongoing.

MEMBERSHIP HANDBOOK:

A family emergency for the final graphical layout person has delayed the Membership Handbook by a day or two. It should be released on the 1st or 2nd of December.

US DOMAIN AUDIT:

This project is now tabled until after the January 2004 renewal. Until work resumes, this project will be dropped from the project list.

FAQ DATABASE:

Not as many questions have been populated as I had hoped, but work is continuing. I expect much more content will be added immediately after the Handbook is released and specific clarifications are requested.

POLICIES DOCUMENTATION:

CONSTITUTION AMENDMENTS:

A vote was conducted and completed for two amendments to the US constitution.

Both were adopted by a substantial margin and results have been announced.

Project is complete.

UNIFIED EMAIL ADDRESSES:

A request has been made to obtain @camarilla.white-wolf.com email addresses for the national staff. This project is now pending the installment of new servers before going live. Project completion date unknown.

ST PRESTIGE AWARDS:

Jason Stafford and ANST- Admin Mary Monroe have agreed to assist in tracking down old prestige awards for the national staff. Project completion date unknown.

IRC PRESTIGE AWARDS:

It is currently extremely difficult to verify prestige awards earned for IRC projects. I will be working to resolve that issue in the near

future. This project has not yet begun. Project start date estimated Jan/Feb 2004.

PRESTIGE REVIEWERS:

Cathryn has completed the hiring process for several new reviewers. Project completed.

OPEN PRESTIGE REVIEWS:

National will begin offering a voluntary audit/review process to those who wish to have a nationally reviewed prestige log to lock their totals. This project will begin in January, after the new prestige reviewers have been trained.

REPORT REVIEWS:

We have started to search reports and address certain chronic issues to try and move everyone into the new club structure. The term "CST" has been our most recent target. Each coordinator using that term in their report to refer to a current office should have been contacted by Jen Kuiper to make corrections. We'll see results in the next reporting cycle.
