Please note that the deadline for coordinators to take the Test of the Coordinator is June 30. This will be enforced. Please don't make me remove as many coordinators as we had to for the Test of Membership.

NEW QUESTIONS:

Q: What's our current ETA for the national database?

A: We have a membership lookup tool available now. The rest of the functionality, as well as truly live data, is waiting on a tie-in to the White Wolf online store. Unfortunately, this project is competing with some pretty major web site redesign work on the main White Wolf site. As we add more and more functionality to the beta test site, though, we move higher than higher on the priority list. It's still hard to give a solid ETA, though.

Q: What's the story with regional events in 2005?

A: There are some revisions in the works. Guidelines should be released soon by the National Conventions Administrator so that we can begin planning 2005's convention schedule.

Q: What should I do if the membership lookup page shows I'm expired, or doesn't show me at all, but I renewed?

A: First, log into the members only section of the main Camarilla web site (<http://camarilla.white-wolf.com/>) and check your membership information there. If it's right there, print that screen and use it for proof of membership

Q: If a coordinator steps down, quits the club and refuses to turn over Camarilla funds, what do we do?

A: This is a sensitive issues that will vary on a case by case basis. Please compose a specific description of what happened and pass it up your coordinator chain so it can be addressed properly.

Q: Where's my membership packet?

A: Packets for those whose memberships were valid as of 3/1/04 should have arrived. If they have not, see the FAQ article at:

LAST MONTH'S QUESTIONS:

Q: I have been told about an award for on time reporting over a period of time. I have been on time for a full year now and was hoping for some info on what this coordinator award is? Can someone help guide

me on this?

A: For every 6 months of Early/On time reporting an awarded is given from National for your efforts. Listings of recipients can be found by going to <http://prestige.camarilla.us/> and clicking on "CC Recognition Award."

Q: Who do I talk to about receiving prestige for moderating a national IC list?

A: Subscribe to the moderators list, and from there all questions can be answered directly.

Q: How much prestige can I get (or award) for donating a car to Goodwill?

A: The maximum award for a single item is 10 prestige, but I think just about everyone can agree that this would be an exceptional donation. With that in mind, talk to the RC about getting an Exceptional Service award approved - that's up to 50 prestige more. 60 prestige may not be much for a car, but hopefully the prestige isn't why you donated in the first place, right?

Q: I have members who do not have email and internet access who have sent in money for renewal is there a way to check on the membership to see if they have renewed yet or not?

A: Contact Jana Wright, the National Services Administrator, at memberservices@white-wolf.com and ask for their current expiration date. This process will become easier when the national database goes live.

Q: How long till the national database is up?

A: Shortly? At the moment, the base portion is completed and debugged, with the only thing left to do being the interface between that and the White Wolf store. As soon as that component works, it will go live with the ability to modify membership data and check expiration dates.

Q: My VST/CC/DC/DST/other officer hasn't passed the Test of Membership. What do I do?

A: First, be aware that they have 90 days from the time they take office to pass the exam. If it hasn't been 90 days, they have time left. If it has been 90 days, let their supervisor know so it can be taken care of. Their supervisor will pass it up the chain as needed to either have the officer removed, or get an exception approved.

Q: What about the Test of the Coordinator?

A: Coordinators have until June 30, or until 90 days after they took office (whichever gives them more time), to pass this exam.

Q: What if I didn't get my membership packet?

A: First, go to <http://camarilla.white-wolf.com/> and log into the members only section. In your membership information, there is a field for "Membership Packet Sent." If that field says 3/2/04, then verify that your address information is correct on the same page. If your address is correct, or after you have corrected it, then contact Jana Wright, the National Services Administrator, at memberservices at white-wolf.com to arrange for a replacement to be sent to you.

Q: My membership packet wasn't sent! Why not?

A: Either your membership was purchased or renewed after 3/1/04, or we may have goofed. If you think we may have goofed, contact Jana Wright at memberservices at white-wolf.com to check things and get on the list for the next batch to go out.

Q: I submitted my prestige log for the voluntary national review, and the totals show that I have enough prestige for a new MC. Does that mean I get it?

A: Not automatically. All the voluntary review does is lock prestige totals themselves. You would then submit your log through the normal process for your actual Member Class (which depends on more than just prestige totals), although the review process this time should be very, very fast since your entire log is a single line item. :)

V. Projects

(Project status is listed as of the time of this report, not necessarily the first of the month.)

NATIONAL DATABASE:

A few final details have to be worked out to finalize interoperability with the White Wolf purchasing system. Once those are done, the system will be publicly announced. Modules are currently being worked on to expand functionality, starting with tracking org units and membership, then a national prestige database. Project lead is Jerry Spaulding, NSA.

UNIFIED EMAIL ADDRESSES:

The domain camarilla.us is being set up to handle email as well as

the URL forwarding currently enabled. As soon as the technical changes are complete, we should be able to give the national staff email addresses @camarilla.us. Project completion date should be within a couple weeks now that the second server is online. Project lead is Wes Contreras, NC.

ST RECOGNITION AWARDS:

Some updates have been made to the ANC: Prestige site, with more to come. Project lead is Cathryn Emerson, ANC: Prestige.

IRC PRESTIGE AWARDS:

We are compiling some of these awards now. When what we have is complete, we'll see about finding the rest. Project lead is currently Dan Wright, ANTA: IRC.

OPEN PRESTIGE REVIEWS:

As of March 27, 2004 the call for the next batch of years has been issued. Members who joined during 1993-1997 or before are invited to have their log reviewed by their CC and DC (if any) and then sent directly to the ANC: Prestige at US-ANC-Prestige at cfl.rr.com for national review. Logs must be in the preferred national format available at <http://prestige.camarilla.us/> . It should be noted that this is solely for prestige point totals. Any MC advancement must go through the normal chain. Project lead is Cathryn Emerson, ANC: Prestige.

DOMAIN LISTS:

Several domains are pending getting email lists set up on the server, though we are experiencing some delays with the tech staff. More are being brought online as time goes by. Expected completion sometime this summer. Project lead is Christy Wellens, ANC: Projects.

DOMAIN / INDY CHAPTER BOUNDARIES:

An audit is being performed to ensure that each domain and independent chapter has defined geographic boundaries. Project is taking longer than expected, with an unknown completion date. Project lead is Jen Kuiper, ANC: Development.

ANST & AANST PRESTIGE:

This report brings us up to date on ST awards with the exception of a few scattered awards still missing, and the month of April. Project

is considered completed at the time.

RST PRESTIGE AWARDS:

Due to various misunderstandings, these awards were not published as they should have. They are currently being compiled for addition to the prestige web site. Project leads are Cathryn Emerson, ANC: Prestige and Ammie Hague, ANC: Admin.

TEST OF MEMBERSHIP:

The deadline for the Test of Membership passed. Storytellers have still not been removed in a comprehensive manner. Project lead for this portion of the project is Jason Stafford, NST. The remainder of the project is complete.

TEST OF THE STORYTELLER:

Currently in beta test. The exam is scheduled for public release on Monday, May 24, with a deadline of August 31 for storytellers to have taken the exam. Project lead is Sarah Contreras, ANSA: Ordeals.

AANC: ARBITRATION:

This position is now filled by Ben Weger. Welcome to the team!

CAMARILLA COUNCIL PRESTIGE:

Still waiting for the Club Director to release awards up to current, at which point the US NC will assume responsibility for ongoing awards. Project lead is Charles Bailey, CD.

MEMBERSHIP PACKETS:
