THIS MONTHS QUESTIONS

Q: How do a reach a DC in another region?

A: First, you can try the CRD. Locate the domain in question and click on the "Domain Coordinator" office in the right-hand column. That will show you the position holder's name, Cam number, and the email they would like to use for that office. If they have not set that email yet, contact the regional coordinator and ask for contact info. All the RCs have email addresses listed at:

Q: What do we do if a member's expiration date does not reflect the free three months of time?

A: Anyone who was a member (even those with a free trial) during December of 2005 should have had their expiration date extended by 3 months. If you know if someone who did not, please either email me or (preferred) log the issue in the bug tracking system at:  
<http://camarilla.white-wolf.com/bugs>

Q: A member of my chapter is assigned to the wrong org unit in the CRD. How do I fix that?

A: Anyone that the CRD thinks is in their coordinator chain can move the member to the correct place. That is, if the member is assigned to your region, the RC can fix it. If the member is assigned to the US,

then the NC can fix it. When in doubt, log the issue in the bug tracker:

Q. Can we use the CRD to track our prestige for audits?

A: While you can enter your prestige into the CRD for your own personal use (or as a backup), I do NOT recommend using it as your primary prestige record at this time. The CRD does not yet fully support the review process, so we can't do a prestige review using just the CRD.

If you've somehow ended up with the CRD as your only prestige log, and it's dozens of lines long (or more), report a case in the bug tracker asking for me to send you a spreadsheet of your prestige entries and I can do that, though the turnaround may be a few days.

## LAST MONTHS QUESTIONS

Q. Does anyone at the National level (or anywhere else for that matter) track the total number of consecutive reports on time (not just six month increments) that a Coordinator has? I'm curious what the record is.

A: The ANC: Chapters tracks whose reports are on time. I wasn't able to track down a record-holder in time for this report, but look in March's issue of the US national newsletter. :)

Q: How to we resolve issues with prestige from the old global settings office?
